

Official Media Arrangements
at the 52nd ASEAN Foreign Ministers' Meeting (52nd AMM)/
Post-Ministerial Conferences (PMC)/
20th ASEAN Plus Three Foreign Ministers' Meeting (20th APT FMM)/
9th East Asia Summit Foreign Ministers' Meeting (9th EAS FMM),
and the 26th ASEAN Regional Forum (26th ARF)
29 July – 3 August 2019, Bangkok, Thailand

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I. Media Accreditation

- Media registration is open between 28 June to 12 July 2019.
- Official media are defined as the photographers and cameramen attached to the official delegation i.e. Office of the Prime Minister, Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Official media should apply as media through the ASEAN Chairmanship website (www.asean2019.go.th) between 28 June to 12 July 2019.
- Official media should submit the following documents with their online application forms (1) A copy of a valid identity card or passport in PDF format, (2) A recent photograph (2x2 inches) in colour against white background, in JPEG format, file size up to 256 kb, and (3) an Equipment list (in case equipment is brought from abroad).
- Successful applicants will receive a confirmation e-mail via the e-mail address provided in their applications.
- Apart from online registration, the Department of Information also requires a list of official media delegation from each participating country through diplomatic channels.
- Official media's badge, press kits, and armband will be distributed by a Media Liaison Officer (MLO) designated to each participating country.
- A media programme will be made available and updated on the ASEAN 2019 Chairmanship website (www.ASEAN2019.go.th).

II. Airports Facilitation

- The Department of Information will facilitate media coverage at airports upon arrival and departure of the Heads of Delegation attending the 52nd AMM/ PMC/ 20th APT FMM/ 9th EAS FMM/ and 26th ARF.
- In cases where the official media is not travelling with the Heads of Delegation, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs will coordinate with relevant agencies to facilitate equipment customs clearance and other related arrival/departure procedures.
- Flight information as well as details on media equipment should be provided to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs as soon as possible.

III. The Media Centre

- Details of the hours of operation of the Media Centre will be made available on www.asean2019.go.th
- Photos and VDO clips of the relevant meetings and functions will be provided to official media and all media to download accordingly.
- Computers, printers, photocopiers, and WiFi will be provided.
- Meals and refreshments will be provided to the registered accredited members of the media.
